1. Revolution Slider



After you have successfully installed the plugin it's time to install the demo content. On a new WordPress installation (where you have no previous content) we recommend you proceed with auto import (go to Theme's options and click on Import tab). If you need to install demo content manually go to Slider Revolution dashboard and click on Import Slider.

Now choose the appropriate zip file from DEMO_CONTENT directory (under REV_SLIDER directory). You have three different sliders to choose from:

- brixton-main-slider-fullwidth (main slider in MAGAZINE BLOG preview)
- Brixton-posts-grid (the grid slider just above the blog in MAGAZINE BLOG preview)
- brixton-widget-video (option for a video in a sidebar widget, can be seen in MAGAZINE BLOG preview, just under the main slider)

After that all you have to do is set where you want the slider to appear. For main slider under the header go to Theme's options and under **Home Page** tab set the Revolution Slider alias (name).



1.2. Common issues

Most common issues are:

- Revolution Slider Error: Slider with alias **slider-name** not found. This means the name in theme's options is not correct. Please check that the name is exactly the same as in Revolution Slider settings.
- Slider appears properly but it's empty (there are no images). This can be caused by two reasons. You either forgot to set categories in Slider Revolution settings or your posts are without featured images. For the first issue please check if you have set the categories properly (check the screenshot below):




2. MAGAZINE WIDGETS



Please note that some creativity was used when creating the layout, especially in last row before the footer. Title of the video was done with a **quote post** and after that single post was selected to present the title for the video on the right.


3. UPPER MENU WIDGET

Top sidebar left and **top sidebar right** are two sidebars used for the bar above the header (extra menu and search widget are placed there in our live demos). While

you can add any widget there, the design will look good only for **custom menu, text widget and search widget.**



4. UPPER MENU WIDGET

List of new widgets in the Theme is:

- **Brixton - Premium Posts with Slider** - a more versatile widget that allows you to choose to display a certain category or even only a single post. You can also add excerpt under the titles and define how many words you wish to display. It is displayed as a slider and you can move between posts with navigation besides the title.

- **Brixton - Premium Video** - allows you to add Youtube, Vimeo or self hosted HTML videos to sidebar.
